KNOXVILLE, TN - August 29, 2022 - Appalachia: A Southeastern Wind Symphony kicks off their fifth season with "Looking Back, Moving Forward." Featuring works old and new performed by collegiate musicians and young professionals from across the southeast, the concert will be held September 3, 7:00 PM at Knoxville Catholic High School.

Musical selections include an arrangement of the traditional hymn, "Be Thou My Vision" by David Gillingham, "La Procession du Rocio," by the 20th century Spanish composer, Joaquin Turina, and the pieces "A Mother of a Revolution" and "Come Sunday" by contemporary American composer, Omar Thomas. The concert will also include the premier of "Looking Back, Moving Forward" by Maryville College alumnus, Chris Blankenship.

Artistic Director, and graduate of The University of Tennessee, Knoxville, **Logan Campbell,** will lead the ensemble of students from colleges across the southeast in a concert about faith and hope for the future.
